THE 15 MOST COSTLY SETTLEMENTS DUE TO TECHNICAL VIOLATIONS

In 2016, The United States Department of Justice recovered over \$4.7 BILLION in fraud-related civil settlements and judgments. The False Claims Act (FCA), Anti-Kickback Statute (AKS), and Physician Self-Referral Law (Stark Law) are just a few of the regulations that have devastated hospitals who failed to remain compliant.

Whether you are aware of the regulations or not, the DOJ has no tolerance for unintentional violations -- filing false claims may result in fines of up to three times the programs' loss PLUS \$11,000 per claim filed.

One of the most common ways hospitals suffer from a false claim is through technical Stark Law violations. These violations often occur when processes aren't automated, resulting in human error. We have included a list of the 15 most costly settlements due to technical violations:
